Continuum of Care

RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT PROGRAMS

SPB

Group Treatment Home (PATHS)

Specialized group treatment home for males with problem sexual behaviors.

- Adolescent males 10-15 years old
- Appropriate for sexually reactive and intra-familial sexual behaviors
- Youth attend public schools
- Regular, structured community activities
- Trauma-informed milieu offering group, individual, and family therapy
- Discharge planning
- Master's and Doctoral level clinicians
- MCO & County funded

Short-Term Residential Care

Short-term (one day to one year) residential for males experiencing family conflict, or otherwise unable to remain in the community as a result of emotional, behavioral, and academic issues.

- Adolescent males 12-18 years old
- On-site academic program
- Group support (ART, Trauma)
- Discharge planning
- County funded

Medically prescribed and supervised residential care for males with behavioral issues rooted in trauma related mental health.

Specialized Transitional Living (Easton Manor).....

Specialized transitional living for males who have completed treatment for problem sexual behaviors.

- Adolescent males 15-20 years old
- PACCT affiliated life skills support
- Job-readiness and employment skills
- Supervised community re-integration
- Group, individual, and family therapy
- MCO & County funded

Specialized Residential Treatment Facility (Mathom House).....

Highly structured specialized residential treatment for males with sexual acting out behaviors.

- Adolescent males 13-19 years old
- Four phase, assessment guided Individual group, and family therapy
- On-site education program
- 45 day Diagnostic program offered
- Individualized evidence-based curricula (CBT, DBT, ART, Good Lives, Boy's Circle)
- Discharge planning
- Master's and Doctoral level clinicians
- MCO & County funded

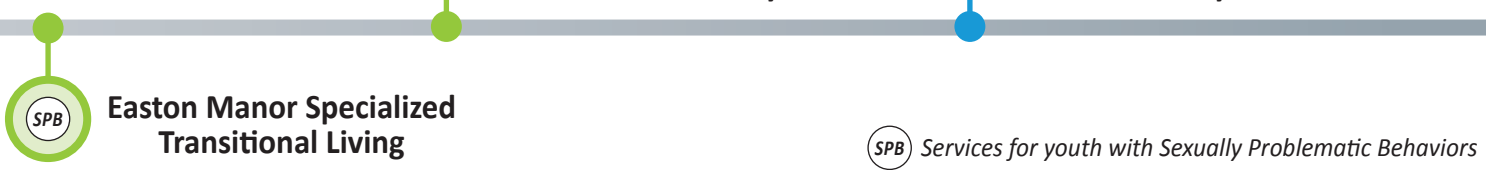
Specialized Psychiatric Residential Treatment Facility.....

Medically prescribed and supervised residential care for males with behavioral and psychiatric disorders, as well as sexually acting out issues who meet medical necessity for RTF level of care.

- Adolescent males 12-18 years old
- On-site Psychiatry and medication management
- Trauma-informed milieu offering group, individual, & family therapy
- Specialized modalities (ART, CBT, DBT, EMDR, HRV)
- Discharge planning
- Master's level clinicians
- MCO & County funded
